the Negro in New York who was coordinating architect in the re-designing of the present United Nations Building at Flushing Meadow?

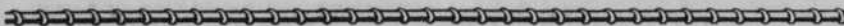
the Negro labor leader in Chicago who rose from station employee to Secretary-Treasurer of one of the country's strongest labor unions?
