Out of the Parent's Room by Six Months if Possible

A child can sleep in a room by himself from the time he is born if convenient, as long as the parents are near enough to hear him when he cries. If he starts with his parents, six months is a good age to move him. He has the strength to take care of himself pretty well, and he won't have set ideas yet about where he wants to be. It is preferable that he not sleep in his parent's room after he is about 12 months old. This seems like the most practical thing to do at the time, but it usually turns out to be a mistake in the end. Even if the child's anxiety improves during the following weeks, he is apt to cling to the security of his parents' bed. In the long run, it's more practical for the parent of the frightened child to bundle up in blankets and sit by his bed, even for an hour in the middle of the night if necessary. I think it's a sensible rule not to take a child into the parents' bed for any reason (even as a treat when the father is away on a business trip.)
