Sunday School Lesson

Subject: "Malachi demands sincere religion."
Scripture Text: Malachi 1:1, 6-9, 2:13, 14-3; 7-12.

Golden Text: "And why call ye me, Lord, Lord, and do not the things which I say?" Luke 6:46.
—Application—
Malachi was the last of the three post-captivity prophets. His book is also the last of the Old Testament. Its burdens of the Book resolves itself into three parts. 1—The sins of the priests. 2—The sins of the people. 3—The "day" of the Lord.


In the days of Malachi, as in our day, the moral and religious condition of the people was at a low ebb. He first calls attention to the fact that God is good.

The love of God in giving food, raiments and peace is so plain as to need no rehearsal, yet mankind from the pulpit through the pew has slipped back into formalism and self righteousness, so now, as then, we need warnings and encouragements rather than promises and reproaches.

The sins of the priests: They only offered the sick, the blind and the lame on God's altar. They did not enter into worship with a pure heart. They spoke of thin tasks as making them weary.

The sins of the people: 1. Paying an unliving wage to the servants. Robbing the widow and the fatherless. 2. A curse put upon sorcerers, adulterers and against liars. 3. Those that rob God will be condemned with a great judgment. (One-tenth of your earnings belong to God. To withhold that tenth or any part of it is to take from Him that which is His) Everyone receiving from the goodness of God should honor Him with their substance.
To do less is to dishonor Him.
