## Williams Religion **School Transferred** To Wilberforce U

The trustees of Western University decided to transfer the students of the Noah W. Williams School of Religion, from the present institution to Payne Theological seminary at Wilberforce university, Wilberforce, Ohio. These students, according to the board, will continue their studies under the same financial obligations made with the Williams school.

The trustees made it plain, however, that Western would continue as a school with a program involving nurse training, health education and recreational leadership training. The properties in Kansas City, Kas., will be remodeled to meet the needs of the new educational setup.

Under order of the last A.M.E. General conference an educational area has been designated including the fifth, first, third, fourth and 13th episcopal districts with Wilberforce university being the key institution.

Dr. Edward A. Scott, who has served as the Williams School of Religion dean for the past two years, has been nominated to the newly-created Noah W. Williams School of Religion and Philosophy
