

Lester Granger Elected Head of Social Workers



ATLANTIC CITY, N. J.—(ANP)—Lester B. Granger, 55, executive secretary of the National Urban League, recently was elected president of the National Conference of Social Work. Election of this New Yorker to office marked the first time in the 78-year history of this organization that a Negro was ever voted to its highest office. Granger has worked with the National Urban League since 1934, and has been executive secretary since 1941. He is a graduate of Dartmouth college. His election was announced on the convention floor in the presence of 6,000 delegates. Ballots had been sent out by mail for this voting.

Spring Apple Salads are Appetizing



Fragrant, spicy red Delicious apples team with green peppers for color and delicious flavor contrast.

SWEET AND SOUR APPLE-CABBAGE SALAD

3 to 4 red Delicious apples	1 tsp. sugar
1/2 cup seedless raisins	1/4 tsp. salt
1 cup shredded cabbage	Pepper
1/2 cup evaporated milk	3 tbsp. vinegar

Dice unpeeled apples. Soak raisins in hot water for a few minutes. Rinse in cold water and drain. Add to diced apples and shredded cabbage. Combine milk, sugar, vinegar, salt and pepper and mix well. Pour over salad. Serves 6.
