The former champion said he had not given up hope of regain ing the crown. He added; "As long as Walcott or Charle has it, we still have hope."
The 12,000 persons who saw last week's fight between Louis and

From the opening bell to the seventh, the tough Argentinian carried the fight to Louis, and was ahead on points for five rounds. But from the seventh on it was Louis all the way.
