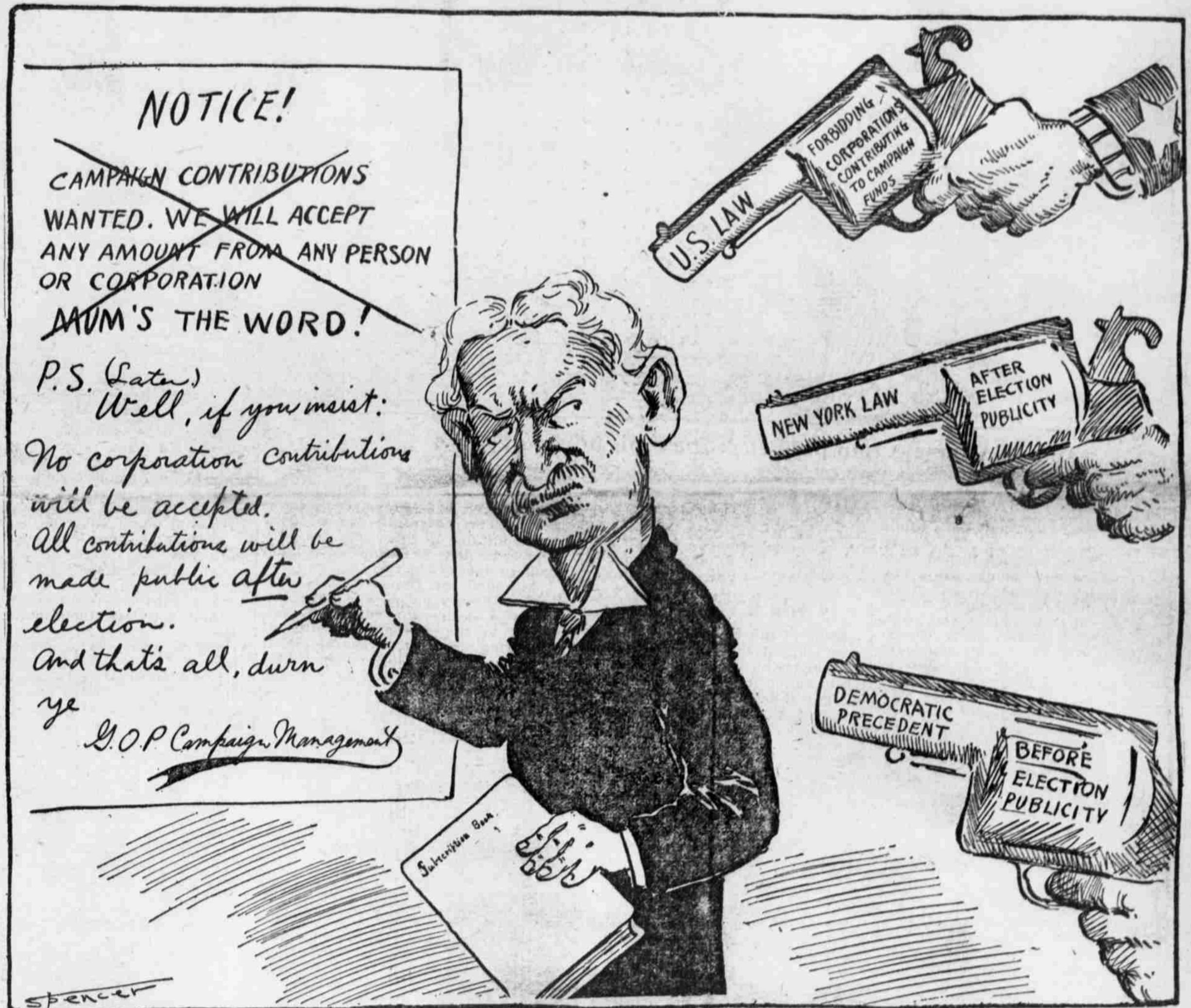

## TWENTY-SEVEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY DOLLARS IN LESS THAN TWO HOURS---AND FROM THE PEOPLE

Guthrie, Oklahoma, July 25.---The Commoner, Lincoln, Nebraska: Notice of my appointment as treasurer of Democratic national committee received at eight o'clock tonight. In less than two hours, without solicitation, I have received from sixty-two local people a total of \$2,780, in sums ranging from one hundred dollars down to one dollar; and not one cent from special interests nor none expecting special privileges, but every dollar from a patriot asking no return but honest government. Oklahoma people prefer to pay their own campaign expenses rather than have our party humiliated by obligations to special interests.
