Note.—On account of the complexity of the Payne glove schedule, it is impossible to make any other than a comparison of the glove rates by using equivalent ad valorem. The new tariff rates on men's, women's, or children's glove finish, Schmaschen, gloves under 14 inches long, is \$1 per dozen pairs; over 14 inches long, 25 cents per dozen for each additional inch over 14; for all other women's or children's gloves wholly or chiefly of leather, under 14 inches long, \$2.50 per dozen pairs, and over 14 inches 25 cents per dozen pairs for each additional inch over 14; all men's leather gloves not thus specifically mentioned, to pay \$2.50 per dozen pairs. The new Tariff Act as agreed upon provides for the following cumulative duties on gloves: On leather gloves, lined with cotton or vegetable fibre, 25 cents per dozen pairs; when lined with knitted glove, silk, leather, or wool, 50 cents per dozen pairs; lined with fur, \$2 dozen, and on all pique gloves, 20 cents per dozen pairs additional.
