WANTED

First: In order to increase the armies now in the field, volunteer infantry, cavalry, and artillery may be enlisted at any time within 90 days...

Second: The period of service for the enlistment and re-enlistment above mentioned, shall be for three years or during the war.

Third: All able bodied men between the ages of 18 and 45 years, who have heretofore been enlisted, and have served for not less than nine months, and can pass the examination required by the mustering regulations of the United States, may be enlisted under this order as veteran volunteers...

Fourth: Every volunteer enlisted and mustered into the service as a veteran under this order shall be entitled to receive from the United States one month's pay in advance, and a bounty and premium of \$402...

Fifth: Upon being mustered into service he shall be paid one month's pay in advance, thirteen dollars; first installment of bounty, twenty dollars; pension, two dollars; total payment on muster, forty dollars.

Sixth: At the first regular pay day after the end of the first year's service an additional installment of bounty will be paid—\$50.

Seventh: Officers of regiments, whose terms have expired, will be authorized, on proper application and approval of their respective Governors to raise companies and regiments within the period of 60 days; and if the company or regiment authorized to be raised shall be filled up and mustered into service within the said period of 60 days, the officers may be re-commissioned of the date of their original commissions, and for the time engaged in recruiting, will be entitled to receive the pay belonging to their rank.

Eighth: Volunteers or militia now in service, whose term of service will expire in 90 days, and who shall then have been in service at least nine months, shall be entitled to the aforesaid bounty and premium of \$402, provided they re-enlist before the expiration of this present term for three years, from date of re-enlistment or for the war, and said bounty and premium shall be paid in the manner herein provided for other troops re-entering the service.

Ninth: Officers in service whose regiments or companies may re-enlist in accordance with the provisions of this order, before the expiration of their present term, shall have their commissions continued, so as to preserve their date of rank as fixed by their original muster into the United States service.

Tenth: As soon after the expiration of their original term of enlistment as the exigencies of the service will permit, a furlough of thirty days will be granted to men who may re-enlist in accordance with the provisions of this order.

Eleventh: Volunteers enlisted under this order will be credited as three years' men in the quotas of their respective States. Instructions for the appointment of recruiting officers and for enlisting veteran volunteers will be immediately issued to the Governors of States.

Army Correspondence. NEW MADRID, Mo., July 21, 1863. DR. ADVERTISER: The 25th Regiment Missouri Volunteers, having at last apparently found a temporary local habitation, I take the liberty through your paper of letting our friends know the state of our pulse, and our condition and prospects.

New Madrid, New Madrid Co. Missouri, is a small town composed of scattered frame houses, and is about the size of the village of Sonora, Atchison Co. Mo., which it also resembles in appearance and location. It is situated upon a wide bottom upon the Mississippi, surrounded by woods and swamps. The water is bad, the best water which can be obtained, being from the Mississippi river, and the location of our camps appears unhealthy, how our boys will get along here remains to be tested. The swamps in this region some fifty or sixty miles back are said to be infested with guerillas, and they are reported to be so hidden in the morasses that they are nearly inaccessible.

Our company had an unsuccessful scout yesterday, of over twenty miles, without having the happiness, as Orpheus O. Kerr would say, "of engaging any confederacies."

Our time, when the little formalities of drill, guard and fatigue duty are got over, is principally devoted to fishing, swimming and laying in the shade; and take it on an average we are enjoying as much "odium cum dignitate" as a poor devil of a private, whose services are worth but thirteen dollars a month, can be expected to, when every brainless disgusting snob, in swelling with the immense importance of a second lieutenant.
