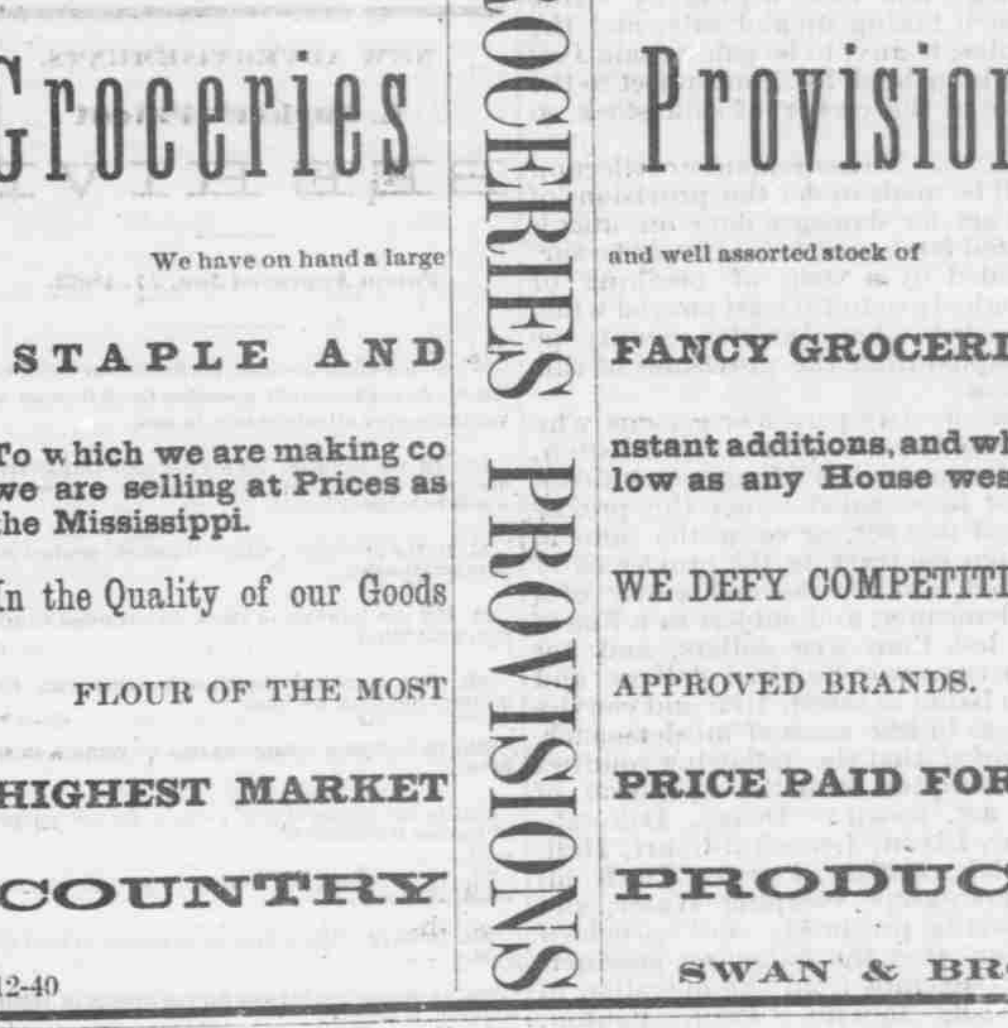


Illustration of a large industrial building, likely a factory or warehouse.

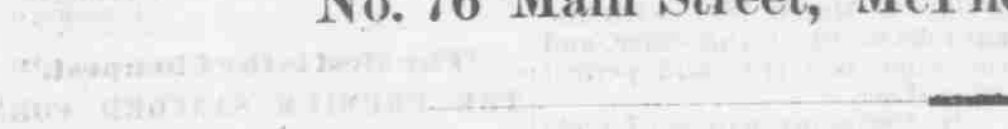


Illustration of a horse-drawn implement, possibly a harrow or similar.

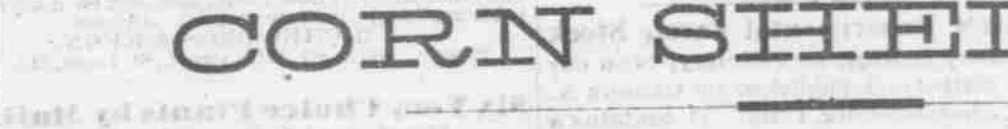


Illustration of a horse-drawn implement, possibly a harrow or similar.

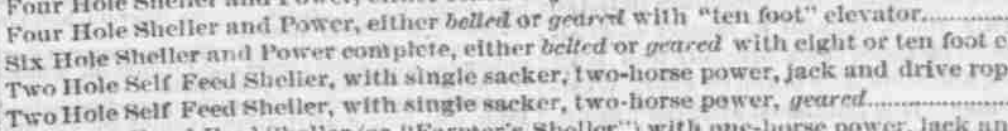


Illustration of a horse-drawn implement, possibly a harrow or similar.

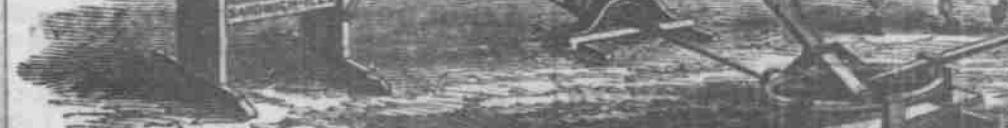


Illustration of a horse-drawn implement, possibly a harrow or similar.

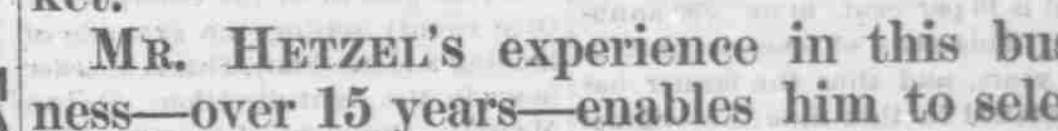


Illustration of a horse-drawn plow.

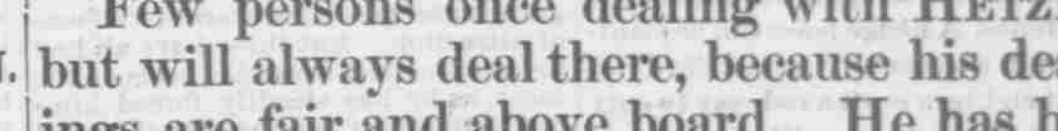


Illustration of a horse-drawn plow.

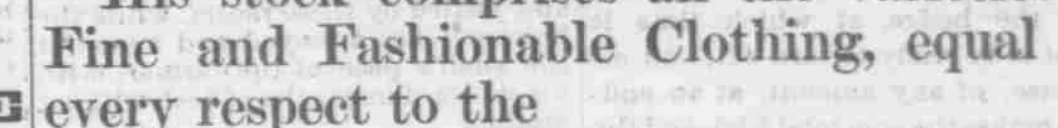


Illustration of a horse-drawn plow.

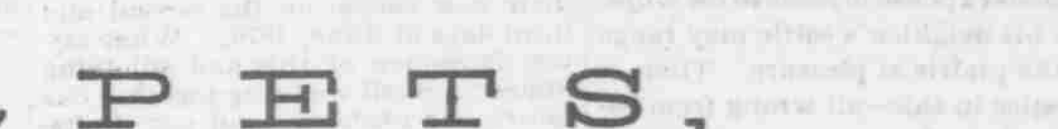


Illustration of a horse-drawn plow.

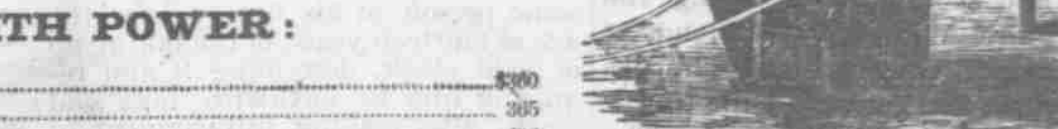


Illustration of a horse-drawn plow.

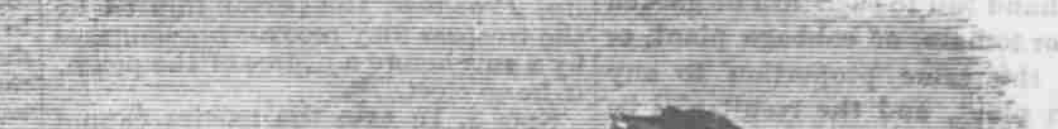

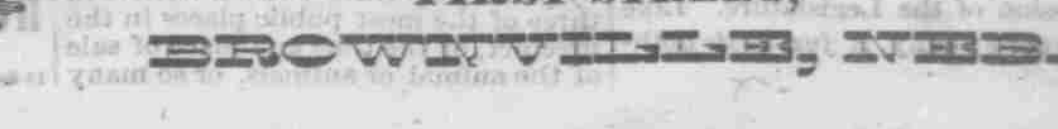
