## County Commissioners' Proceedings.

At an adjourned meeting of the Board of County Commissioners held April 7th and 8th, 1882. Present, Frank Redfern, J. H. Shook, John H. Pohlman, Commissioners; J. B. Docker, Co. Clerk; G. W. Tate, Sheriff, when the following business was done, to-wit: Erroneous assessment of D. E. C. Long, it appearing to the board that there is an erroneous assessment on the assessment list of D. E. C. Long. Ordered that the taxes be reduced from 8200 to \$40, and county treasurer was authorized to reduce the taxes to that amount.

Delinquent taxes on W14 NW14 SW 14 35-7-15, delinquent for the years 1869 to 1879, inclusive. Ordered that the county treasurer take 50 per cent and costs on the above described land.

Erroneous assessment on SE 1/4 29-5-14. Ordered that the county treasurer receive \$18 in full of taxes for the year 1881. It appearing that the assessment as made is erroneous.

Delinquent taxes on lot 3 block 3, Brownville. Delinquent for the years 1874 to 1881, inclusive. Ordered that the certificate of tax sale be transferred and assigned to J. S. Church at 50 per cent.

Delinquent taxes on NW1 36-6-14. delinquent for the years 1870 to 1878, inclusive. It appearing to the board that the above described land is school land and wrongfully taxed for the above years, the county treasurer was ordered to cancel said taxes for the above mentioned years.

Delinquent taxes on lots 1, 2, 3, 10, 11, and 12, block 11, St. Deroin. Delinquent for the years 1873 to 1880. Ordered that the county treasurer take 50 per cent and costs on the above

Delinquent taxes on N1/2 NE1/4 and SW14. 36-4-e6. Delinquent for the years 1873 to 1880, inclusive. Ordered that the treasurer take \$5 on the above land in full of taxes.

Erroneous assessment of W1/2 NE1/4 and NE¼ NW¼. 16-4-14. Ordered that the assessment on the above land is erroneous and the treasurer is authorized to strike the same off of the tax list, the same being school land.

Petition presented by J. Mariatt, et. al., asking the appointment of George Rhodes supervisor in Aspinwall precinct. Prayer of petition granted.

H. D. Snyder was appointed Deputy County Treasurer, by request of county treasurer.

Ordered that Eli Wilcox be allowed for extra work on delinquent tax books, etc.

A contract was entered into between C. W. Wheeler and the board to build a combination I ridge across Roy's bran h on Tecumseh road.

The following official bonds were approved; Joshua Rogers, deputy sheriff; B. H. Bailey, constable; Geo. Rhodes, supervisor; H. O. Minick, supervisor.

Amount of funds expended: On general fund, \$1,734.08.

On bridge fund, \$66.37,

On road fund, \$3,00.
