The crusade against railroads is to be commenced again. Every state convention that has assembled west of the Alleghenies this fall, no matter by what name the party is called, has been vehement in its denunciation of "monopolies." And yet the railroads were never giving better rates or showing more fairness than at the present time.—Omaha Republican.

It is reported that John Blacklaw, of Pawnee county, once a resident of this county, was shot and killed recently by accident, by Mr. Becker who was looking for horse thieves. Blacklaw was approaching Becker's house when he was mistaken for a horse thief and shot dead. Blacklaw was a county commissioner at the time. A Topeka telegram says: "A new movement is afloat in Kansas to defeat St. John for governor. Some leading Republicans are said to be at the head of it.
