VERY LATEST FROM VERACRUZ

Half an hour previous to the sailing of the Herald it was certainly reported at Vera Cruz that Miramon had abandoned the siege, deserted his army and taken refuge on board the French brig-of-war "El Sacrificio."

Miramon's communications to the rear had been entirely cut off, and his army was in a desperate situation—unable to communicate with the hospital, or to receive supplies from the country to any considerable extent.

The capture of the Maria piratical steamer was a fatal stroke to his enterprise, and it is believed Miramon now only demands liberal terms for his followers. The city of Mexico also has pronounced against Miramon, and his army were deserting him at every opportunity...
