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GOVERNOR'S PROCLAMATION.

STATE OF NEBRASKA.

WHEREAS, The Constitution of the State of Nebraska provides, that "the Legislature may, on extraordinary occasions, be convened by Proclamation of the Governor and when so convened, shall meet in no other place than such as shall be the object for which they were so convened, to be state in the Proclamation of the Governor"; and

WHEREAS, In accordance with the provisions of the Constitution, and by virtue of the authority invested in me, I, David Butler, Governor of the State of Nebraska, do call upon the members of the Legislature of the said State, to meet at the City of Lincoln, on Thursday, the 17th day of March, A. D. 1870, at the hour of 2 o'clock P. M., for the purpose of taking action on the following subjects of legislation:

First.—The Ratification of the proposed Fifteenth Amendment to the Constitution of the United States.

Second.—To provide for the erection of the Penitentiary.

Third.—To authorize the County Commissioners of Cass County to issue bonds, amounting to \$50,000, for Bridge purposes.

Fourth.—To extend the Jurisdiction of Probate Judges, in civil cases.

Fifth.—To provide for the care and custody of State prisoners.

Sixth.—The passage of a Militia Law.

Seventh.—The encouragement of Immigration.

Eighth.—The relinquishment of State jurisdiction over lands where the General Government have erected, or propose to erect public buildings.

Ninth.—The Amendment of Section 2 and Section 3, of the act entitled "An act to enable counties, cities, and precincts to borrow money on their bonds, or to levy taxes for the construction and maintenance of works of internal improvement in this State, and legislative bonds already issued for such purposes," approved February 14th, 1869, so far as said sections provide for the annual payment of any portion of the principal of bonds so issued.

Tenth.—To provide for relief in cases where counties have voted or levied taxes in excess of the amount required for the construction and maintenance of the principal of the said act.

Eleventh.—To amend the act entitled "An act to amend Section 1, of an act to provide for the publication of the decisions of the Supreme Court and for the payment of the Reporter," approved Feb. 15th, 1869.

Twelfth.—To ratify and confirm a certain contract made by the Governor for the conversion of certain lands for John Cahn and John C. Keay, to all the development of the State interests of the State.

Thirteenth.—To amend an act entitled "An act to incorporate cities of the first class, in the State of Nebraska," approved February 5th, 1869.

Fourteenth.—To amend Chapter 58 Revised Statutes, entitled "Towns."

Fifteenth.—To make preparations for necessary additional expenses of State Officers.
