leaves with three ounces of soft water; give a teaspoonful every hour until the symptoms abate.

This is a Chicago treatment. Another, and perhaps the best for all persons, because the simplest, is the following:

Let the medicine should be given, as there is more danger of giving too much than not enough.

Medicines, however, are but a poor resort; good nursing is the main and best "hol" you can take, to cure the zoot.

The discharge which frightens most practitioners, is the best symptom, and is not the cause of the disease.

There is no doubt it will be his run here, as elsewhere, and country horse will be no exception.

Keep cool, let your hair grow, and don't pull or drive your horses and the "zoot" will soon leave.

Prostration of strength; loss of appetite, hot mouth and sore throat; swollen eyes; cough frequently; pulse quick, 70 to 75; eyes watery and red; discharge from nose; cold legs and ears; disposition to droop; looseness of bowels.

Keep the patient well blanketed in a clean, dry stable; give it a steaming, by placing a peak of sawdust into a bag, and so using this to the head, and steam from the oats will be inhaled, until discharge from nostrils is of a natural color.
