THE PATRIARCH of this delegation and of the House, is the Hon. H. W. Farley of Weeping Water.

Mr. Farley is a native of the old Granite State having been born in the town of Hollis, in the year 1823; he is consequently in the 51th year of his age.

His height is five feet six and one-half inches; weight 150 pounds. In the year 1848 he settled in Roxbury, Massachusetts, now a part of the city of Boston, where he engaged in the business of carriage making.

In consequence of a severe affliction of chronic bronchitis, his physician advised him to go West—as far as he could find civilization—and in accordance with that advice, he sold out his business and removed to this State, settling at Weeping Water in the year 1857.

11 years after his settlement in Roxbury. Since his removal to this State his old disease has gradually subsided and though not entirely cured, he finds himself greatly benefited by the change.

Though accustomed only to city life in his early days, when he came to this Territory he engaged in the business of farming, and while fortune has not been propitious to his efforts, yet by diligence and frugality he has been able to acquire a comfortable estate and a quiet home for his declining years.

In his early days, Mr. Farley was a Whig, but upon the organization of the Republican party, found himself in hearty sympathy with the new deal, since which time and all the fluctuations of political strife, he has never found occasion to desert his post or discard his loyalty.

It is his pride that in the Republican party had neither fame nor fortune he joined himself to it on account of its immutable principles, and as those principles have never changed, so his love has not waned.

In the Legislature of Mr. Farley is a man of mark, and will attract attention in any assembly. In his own county he is esteemed as one of the most influential of his public men, and should his life be continued, his future will doubtless be one of still greater usefulness.

J. L. BROWN is the youngest member of this House, being only 36 years of age. He was born in New York, and is engaged in farming near Plattsmouth.

His height is 5 feet 9 inches, and his weight, on account of long continued illness, is only 125 lbs. He is in his 27th year, an important occasion, and always accompanied with his wife, whose attentions to her sick companion are marked by the most devoted affection and selflessness.
