The Nebraska Convention instructed its delegates to vote for Blaine and Bristow.

The friends of Hitchcock numbered within tea as many as the friends of all other aspirants for the senatorship.

The State Convention at Omaha exhibited extraordinary if not a disgraceful feature. The object of the Convention was to select gentlemen from the Republican party to represent the State at Cincinnati.

Previous to the convention Douglas county got into a wrangle about its delegates, and elected two sets of representatives. One class including nearly all the prominent men of Omaha, Ex. Gov. Saunders, Chief Justice Lake, Judge Briggs, and Gen. Manserson.

On motion J. S. Gilham was elected Secretary pro tem. Mr. A. M. DeClerq of Franklin county, being present, was invited by the Chair to make remarks.

On motion a local institute was appointed to convene at the Cloverton School House in Glenwood precinct, on Friday the 9th of June, and hold a session of two days.

We feel that an explanation is due to Mr. Parker of Guide Rock and Mr. Kellogg of Red Cloud, in relation to the call for a County Convention. Some two weeks before the convention we thought it necessary to call a convention to show outsiders that we were alive and moving.

We hope this explanation will prove satisfactory. The lateness of the day demanded unauthorized action on our part, and that is our apology.

PRES GRANT has reorganized his cabinet. Pierpont goes to England as foreign minister, Secretary Taft takes Pierpont's place as Attorney General, and Don Cameron takes the place of Judge Taft as Secretary of War.

He controls the fifty-eight delegates of Pennsylvania, and will check them over to Conkling. It is supposed by Conkling's admirers that this added strength will give him such precedence over the other candidates as to assure his nomination.

The re-organization of the Cabinet is thought by some to be simply an effort to strengthen the Republican party by giving all the doubtful states of the north representation in the administration.

A Sunday School Convention has been called to assemble in Fremont on the 7th and 8th of June. Extensive arrangements have been made to secure a large attendance, and an interesting and profitable time is anticipated.
