THE Loup City Times says that Olive's cattle are dying off, and claims that it is the vengeance of a just God. The "vengeance" has been pretty evenly distributed over the entire range the present winter.

MR. FERNANDO Wood died recently, and Senator Matt Carpenter of Wisconsin was called away last week by the relentless hand of death. It seems that the great men of the country are all dying off, we haven't felt well for more than a week or so.

A BILL to amend the constitution of the state by striking out the word "male" thus giving to women the right to vote, was passed by the legislature, and we suppose the proposition will be presented to the people to be voted upon at the next general election.

THE apportionment bill as passed gives to Webster county one representative, and to Webster and Franklin counties together one representative. The 23rd Senatorial district is composed of Webster, Franklin and Nuckolls counties, and is entitled to one Senator.

THE Union Pacific has contracted for 37,000 tons of sixty-pound steel rails, 5,000 tons of forty-pound rail, twelve first class passenger coaches, five first-class narrow gauge coaches, 500 box cars, 900 cattle cars, eighteen ten wheeler, Taunton engines, and twenty-five narrow gauge engines, to be delivered during the present year.

TREE Planting in Nebraska, 1881. There were planted in Nebraska during the year, as shown by returns, fifty-three million, ninety-two thousand and eighty-eight forest trees, two million four hundred and forty thousand and forty-six fruit trees, four hundred and sixty-four thousand, four hundred and twenty grape vines.

WE quote official reports filed with the auditor of the state. A very extensive personal knowledge of what has really been done in tree planting warrants a belief that these figures are greatly below the facts—that many more were planted than were returned.—Neb. Farmer.

THE total expense of running the state treasury for the year 1879, was \$25,108.50; for the year 1880, \$25,198.20.

MR. J. H. STATOS, the Pawnee City druggist, arrested for selling liquor without license paid a fine and costs amounting to \$214.55.

LOUP City held a railroad meeting on the 19th to devise means to induce Sherman county in communication with the rest of the world.

W. F. CODY, "Buffalo Bill," is going to build a handsome row of brick buildings in North Platte, and will also erect an opera house in the spring.

MARTIN J. LYDELL, a young man sixteen years of age, was caught by his scarf in the Rockford mill machinery in Valley county and strangled to death.

THE quartermaster at Fort Niobrara has advertised for bids for the delivery of 100,000 pounds of corn and 70,000 pounds of oats at that post in May.

MICHAEL DONEY, of Jackson, was shot and instantly killed by Patrick Boyle, at Jackson, last week. The general opinion is that the act was done in self-defense.

THE Plum Creek Pioneer denies that J. P. Oltz, the Carter county man-burner has fled from the state. It says that he is living quietly in that town with his family.

S. L. BARRETT, superintendent of public instruction in Platte county, forged school district orders, and last week being detected in his crime, fled from Columbus and escaped.
