Sec. 17. The election of each town shall have power at their annual meetings to elect such town officers as may be required to be chosen to direct the institution and defense of suits at law or in equity in which such town may be a party in interest; to direct such suits to be raised in such town for the support and maintenance of roads and bridges, or for any other purpose provided by law as they may deem necessary; to take measures and give directions for the exercise of their corporate powers; to impose penalties upon persons offending against any such regulations; and to make all rules, regulations, and by-laws necessary to carry into effect the powers herein granted.

Sec. 18. Every person chosen or appointed to the office of supervisor, town clerk, assessor, town treasurer, or overseer of highways, before he enters upon the duties of his office and within ten days after he shall be notified of his election or appointment, shall take and subscribe before some authorized person as high or as low as faithfully and impartially performs the duties of his office as prescribed by law, and shall cause a certificate of the same to be filed in the office of the town clerk.

Sec. 23. All town officers except justice of the peace and constables, shall hold their office for one year and until their successors are qualified.

Sec. 33. On Tuesday following the annual town meeting he shall account to town board, for all moneys received and disbursed by him in his official capacity.

Sec. 42. Assistant supervisors, and supervisors elected in the cities of the first and second class, shall be members of the county board of their respective counties, and shall and enjoy the same powers and rights as other members.
