Our Candidates.

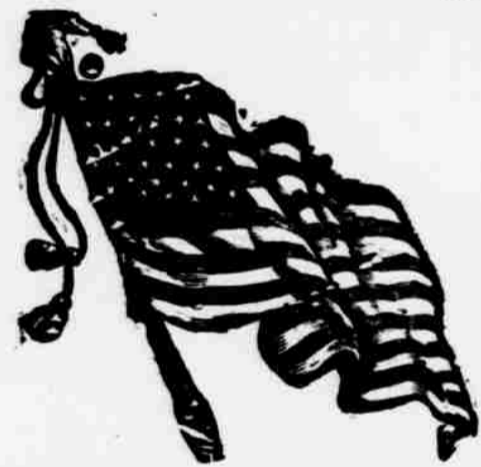

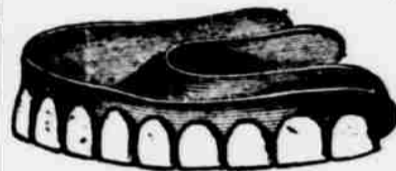
