When does old age begin? At forty-five, it is said, the amount of combustion which keeps the furnace of the human body in blast commences to decrease and diminishes until three-score years and ten, more or les, when the fires are drawn and the flickering flame dies out. That is the physiological way of looking at it. But some men are old before they are out of their teens, while others apparently never grow old, though they live to be centen-arians. The poet's way of looking at it is the best:






