THE CEYLON BUFFALO.

Queer-Looking Animal That Likes to Wallow in Mnd.

The horns of the Ceylon buffalo are very capricious in their development.

In some they are short and stubby, curv-

ing back at a considerable angle; in others they extend back with only a

slight curve, running almost parallel with the neck. Others again extend from the head at right angles, curve gracefully upward and grow to enormous proportions of length and thickness, frequently measuring aix feet from tip to

tip, with a circumference of fifteen inches at the base.
