At the same time the cylinder turns gears which attract the attention of the passengers to the announcement made by the cylinder. There are many fine window displays made by our merchants this week notably among which are Miner Bros., Nebraska Mercantile Company, Cowden-Kaley Company, C. L. Cotting, Galusha & Wescott, Berg & Smith and Sherwood & Albright. One of the most artistic of these window decorations that has ever been in the city is the display in the north window of Turnure Bros. dry goods department. The representation is that of a latticed portico on each side of which stands a doll in the act of driving shoes which stand in the bottom of the window. The work was done by Walter Kaley and Miss Mabel McMillan.

C. H. Wiggins living about seven miles east of this city on the south side of the river, was in the city Monday and had on exhibition a fine specimen of the American eagle which he shot during the blizzard of last Saturday. The bird measured six feet and eight inches from tip to tip. The talons when opened measured seven and three-fourths inches, and the larger of the four claws on each foot measured two and three-fourths inches and the three smaller ones each one and three-fourths inches, and were as sharp as needles. The bird was one of the finest specimens which has yet been captured in this vicinity.

One of the most important results of the recent visit of Commissioner General Peck to Paris was the acquirement of space for a "corn kitchen" at the exposition, in which will be illustrated on a very extensive scale all the culinary possibilities and dietetic virtues of our Indian corn, maize. It will be the object of this "kitchen" to demonstrate to the people of the old world, particularly the Asiatics, that our Indian corn is convertible into a greater variety of wholesome and healthful food products and contains more nutrition than any cereal known to the arts of husbandry. It will be shown that those nations which suffer from crop failures and food famines have within their reach a food product that is cheap and is capable when properly prepared, of sustaining human energy and strength in any climate and in any occupation.
