This paragraph replies to the repeated insinuations by an Omaha paper and based upon the purchase of certain lots adjacent to the university campus.

Last winter the legislature was asked to appropriate \$8,000 for the purchase of real estate near the university, neither the number nor the description of the lots being given. Later it was discovered that but \$5,000 was expended in this way, and while no direct accusation was made, the public was led to believe that the chancellor had received \$8,000, expended \$5,000 and placed the balance where he thought it would do the most good.

It is explained that the \$8,000 was asked for with a view of picking up stray lots here and there near the campus, that \$5,000 has been so invested, and that the remainder of the appropriation remains in the state treasury and will remain there until the board sees fit to invest it in other property.

The regents also explain that the constitution of the state, as well as acts of the legislature, leave the board no option but to receive all donations made to the institution. The board's interpretation of the law in this respect is hotly disputed by those opposed to accepting the offer, and the verbal war goes merrily on, but with the charges of fraud in the real estate deal eliminated.

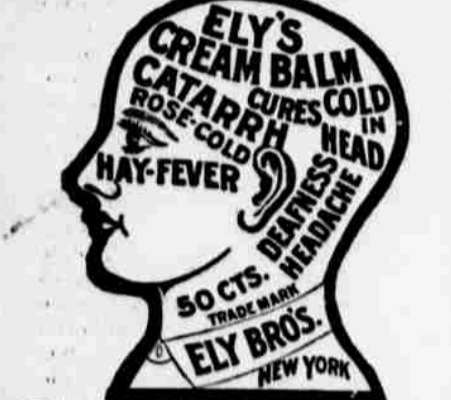
