Lincoln Letter.

LINCOLN, NEB., June 1. The state central committee organized for the coming year, last Wednesday evening, by electing H. F. Lehr, of Albion, chairman, and retaining in office Arthur B. Allen of Johnson county, secretary, and A. B. Henning, of Omaha, treasurer. Charles H. Sloan, of Filmore county, was selected vice chairman, this office being created at the suggestion of the candidates. Mr. Lehr, the new chairman, has long been admired by a number of the party leaders who believe in practical methods in politics. He is an organizer, a pusher, a winner, and, better than all that, there is no nasty stench arising where he is at work. Mr. Lehr believes in clean, straightforward work, and hopes to win success in the campaign this year, because there are enough republican votes waiting to be cast in Nebraska this year to snow the opposition under, and because he will see to it that they are cast. He was selected as chairman at the suggestion of the candidates, some of whom had long admired the manner in which he looked after affairs in Boone county while chairman of its organization.

After selecting the officers, the committee took up the matter of location and by rather close vote decided to remove the headquarters to Omaha. Both factions of the Douglas county republicans pleaded for the change, predicted that it would result in a heavier vote, and agreed to smother old feuds and work harmoniously for the entire ticket. The change was made wholly because it was thought that the presence of the headquarters at Omaha might serve to unite the warring elements and there are indications that it will have that effect.

From 1892 to 1894 he was insurance deputy in the auditor's office, and was again appointed to that position in 1901 when Auditor Weston assumed control. Upon the election of Mr. Mortensen he at once settled upon Mr. Babcock as his deputy because of the long-standing friendship and mutual esteem which existed between the two Valley county pioneers.
