Sloan, of Filmore county, was selected vice chairman, this office being created at the suggestion of the candidates. Mr. Lehr, the new chairman, has long been admired by a number of the party leaders who believe in pracital methods in politics. He is an organizer, a pusher, a winner, and, better than all that, there is no nasty stench for before. When calling for above arising where he is at work.
