Lincoln Letter.
LINCOLN, NEB., June 28,

H. F. Lehr, of Albion, chairman of the republican state central committee, has resigned his position at the head of that body, and Secretary Arthur B. Allen has called the candidates and the committee to meet at the Lindell hotel in Lincoln, next Thursday evening at 8 o'clock for the purpose of considering the resignation and, in case it should be accepted, selecting a successor. Mr. Lehr announced his intention of quitting the committee in a letter to the secretary in which he stated that he had just been informed by his physician that Mrs. Lehr could not be expected to recover for some time and that he could not expect to leave her for at least six weeks. As the season for active campaign work is fast approaching, Mr. Lehr felt that it would not be just to the party, the candidates, the committee or himself to continue to hold the chairmanship when it was manifestly impossible for him to serve actively.

The state school for guard officers, and the examinations which followed it, passed off very methodically and satisfactorily and the result was a generous measure of praise from Brigadier General Aaron S. Daggett the government officer in charge, which praise was all the more appreciated by those who knew that General Daggett is not an adept in the gentle art of flattery, and believes in stating nothing but blunt truths when discussing military organizations. The officers of the Fremont signal corps covered themselves with glory by sending a heliograph message of twelve words a mile or more and placing the answer in General Culver's hands in a few seconds less than three minutes. The officer at the outer station was not aware that a speed test was being made.

The delegates to the national convention returned in a most happy and optimistic frame of mind. The convention could have done nothing which would have added to their pleasure unless it would have been to nominate a Nebraskan for vice president. All were agreed that if Nebraska was not to receive the plum, Fairbanks was the man for the place. One of the state officers who attended the convention expressed his delight with the absolute harmony which appeared on every hand, and stated that it was the only convention, great or small, in which he had not heard a cross word spoken by any delegate, in session or without. Compare this harmonious, enthusiastic, contented and industrious brigade of campaigners with the tumultuous, warring, scalping vendetta which will assemble at St. Louis next month, and it does not take a political astrologer to predict the outcome of the campaign with the utmost certainty.
