**Order to Show Cause.**

IN THE COUNTY COURT,  
 State of Nebraska,  
 Webster County.

At a county court held at the county court room in and for said county, August 21, A. D. 1904.

In the matter of the estate of John A. Benson, deceased.

On reading and filing the petition of E. M. Benson, praying that administration of said estate may be granted to E. M. Benson, as administrator.

Ordered, that Saturday the 20th day of August A. D. 1904, at 10 o'clock a. m., is assigned for hearing said petition when all persons interested in said matter may appear at a county court to be held in and for said county and show cause why prayer of petitioner should not be granted; and that notice of the pendency of said petition and the hearing thereof be given to all persons interested in said matter, by publishing a copy of this order in the Red Cloud Chief, a weekly newspaper printed in said county, for three consecutive weeks prior to said day of hearing.

**Proposed Constitutional Amend.**

The following proposed amendment to and convention for the revision of, the constitution of the State of Nebraska, as hereinafter set forth, in full, is submitted to the electors of the State of Nebraska, to be voted upon at the general election to be held Tuesday, November 8, A. D. 1904:

(SENATE FILE NO. 114.)  
 A Bill for a Joint Resolution recommending to the electors of the state to vote at the next election of members of the Legislature for or against a convention to revise, amend and change the Constitution of the State of Nebraska in accordance with Section 2, Article 15, of the Constitution of the State of Nebraska.

Be it Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Nebraska.

1. That it is deemed necessary to call a convention to revise, amend and change the Constitution of the State of Nebraska.

2. That the electors are recommended to vote at the next election of members of the Legislature for or against a convention to revise, amend and change the Constitution of the State of Nebraska.

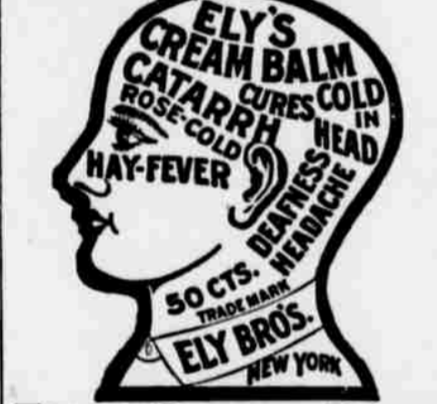
3. That at such next election of members of the Legislature on the ballot of each elector voting at such election, shall be printed or written in such manner that the elector can indicate his preference under the law the words "FOR" calling a convention to revise, amend and change the Constitution of the State of Nebraska, and "AGAINST" calling a convention to revise, amend and change the Constitution of the State of Nebraska; and if a majority voting, at said election shall vote for a convention, the Legislature shall, at its next session, provide by law for calling the same.

I, Geo. W. Marsh, Secretary of State of the State of Nebraska, do hereby certify that the foregoing proposed amendment to the Constitution of the State of Nebraska, is a true and correct copy of the original enrolled bill passed by the Twenty eighth session of the Legislature of the State of Nebraska, as it appears from said original bill, on file in my office, and that said proposed amendment and revision of the Constitution of the State of Nebraska is submitted to the qualified voters of the State of Nebraska, for their adoption or rejection, at the general election to be held on Tuesday, the 8th day of November, A. D. 1904.

In testimony whereof, I hereunto set my hand and affixed the Great Seal of the State of Nebraska, this 5th day of July, in the year of our Lord One Thousand Nine Hundred and Four, of the Independence of the United States the One Hundred and Twenty Ninth and of this state the Thirty Eighth.
