### Financial Condition of the City of Red Cloud, May 5, '09

We find the following unpaid bonds and judgments against the city at this date.

An old issue of Electric Light bonds for \$1000 due April 1st, 1903 bearing 6 per cent interest.

A second issue of Electric Light bonds for \$10,000 dated April 20, 1906 and due April 20, 1926 bearing 4 1/2 per cent interest.

An issue of Water bonds for \$22000 refunded August 1st, 1904 and due August 1st, 1924 bearing 4 1/2 per cent interest.

A judgment against the city for \$577.16 dated May 18th, 1908 in favor of Sunderland Roofing and Supply Co., bearing 7 per cent interest.

A second judgment against the city for \$927.24 dated May 18th, 1908 in favor of Westinghouse Manufacturing Co., bearing 7 per cent interest.

A judgment in favor of C. S. Olmsted for \$2000 dated April 24th, 1908.

We find the condition of the various funds and levies to be as follows:

We find unpaid registered warrants for \$7207.35 drawn on "Electric Lights." We can not find that the city council ever created such a fund.

Total receipts for the fiscal year from all sources \$171633

Total disbursements for same time \$17692.97 not including outstanding warrants. Total outstanding warrants not registered \$785.86.
