Ordinance No. 74.

An ordinance providing for and levying taxes upon all taxable property in the city of Red Cloud, Nebraska, both real and personal for all general and special purposes according to the assessed valuation of said city for the fiscal year commencing the first Tuesday in May 1909.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Red Cloud, Nebraska:

Section 1. That there be and hereby is levied upon all the taxable property within the city of Red Cloud, Nebraska both real and personal for the purpose of defraying the expenses of said city for the current year the following taxes upon each dollar of the assessed valuation thereof for the specified funds to wit:

General Fund 10 mills.
Water Bond Fund 3 mills.
Electric Light Bond Fund 3 mills.
Maintaining Water Works 4 mills.
Maintaining Electric Light Works 2 mills.
Street Lights 4 mills.
Judgment Fund 10 mills.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication.

Ordinance No. 75.

An ordinance termed The Annual Appropriation Bill appropriating such sums of money as are necessary to pay all expenses and liabilities of the city of Red Cloud, Nebraska as set forth by previous estimate made for the current year.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of Red Cloud, Nebraska:

Section 1. That the following sums of money be and the same are hereby appropriated from the amount of taxes authorized to be levied for the current year to defray the necessary expenses and liabilities of the said City of Red Cloud for the current fiscal year and for the purposes hereinafter stated:

General Fund	\$ 2000.00
Water Bond Fund	800.00
Electric Light Bond Fund	800.00
Maintaining Water Works	1000.00
Maintaining Electric Light Works	500.00
Street Lights	1000.00
Judgment Fund	200.00

Total \$ 6300.00

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication.

Notice To Creditors

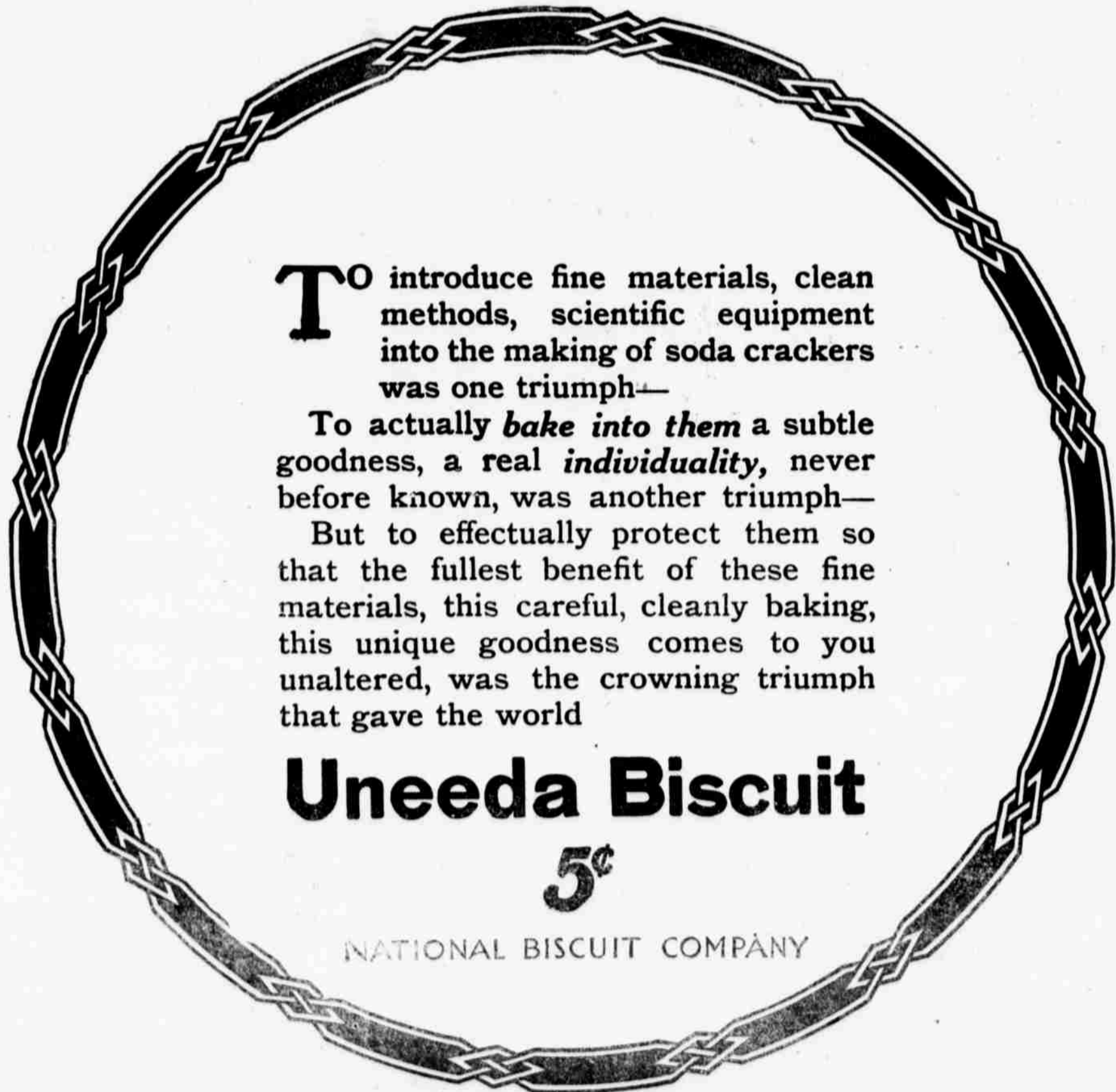
State of Nebraska, in the County of Webster.
