### Champion Carrier Pigeons.

B. A. Foggs of Hants Mills, Garland, is the possessor of some rare carrier pigeons. He has one pair of which the father and mother have a record of flying from Minneapolis, Minn., to Boston in 50 hours. For the last thousand miles of their flight they flew against a northeast storm, arriving with ice and snow frozen to their plumage. This pair had never flown west of Buffalo before. They partook of no food on their trip. Mr. Foggs also has a pair of English carriers, the father and mother having a record of flying over 5000 miles. These birds are the same breed as those that flew from the balloon of Capt. Nansen, the Norwegian explorer, who perished in his attempt to reach the North pole. He has also 12 homing pigeons that have been flying from points in Malaya. One pair has a record of flying from the Tsimshian Gulf around to Durban, 25 miles, in 26 minutes, and from Shikwemek, 50 miles, in 69 minutes.—Kitchener Journal.

### Ordinance No. 74.

For purposes providing for and levying taxes upon all property in the city of Red Cloud, Nebraska, both real and personal, for all general and special purposes, continuing to the amount herein specified and for the payment of expenses of the city government and the maintenance of the same.

The amount of money required is \$10,000.

Section 1. There shall be made hereby a tax upon all taxable property within the city of Red Cloud, Nebraska, and upon all property for the purpose of returning the amount necessary for the payment of the debts of the city of Red Cloud, Nebraska, for the year ending December 31, 1898.

Section 2. This ordinance shall remain in force and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

### Ordinance No. 75.

An ordinance termed the Annual Appropriation Bill appropriating such sums of money as are necessary to pay all expenses and liabilities of the city of Red Cloud, Nebraska, set forth by previous estimate made for the current year.

It is ordained by the Mayor and Council of Red Cloud, Nebraska:


