Dr. Rickard Killed Beneath His Auto

Machine Turns Turtle Near Weeping Water and Physician's Back Broken.

Weeping Water, Neb., Nov. 8.—Dr. E. T. Rickards, a prominent physician of this city, was found dead under his automobile about a mile east of here early this morning. He had been dead about four hours when discovered.
About 9:30 in the morning he had been called to see a patient in the country. While going at a high rate of speed his machine ran into a culvert at a turn in the road and was overturned. Dr. Rickards was crushed underneath and was probably killed instantly.
Doctor Rickards was about forty years old. He had been located in Weeping Water for almost twelve years, and was well known in this vicinity.
Dr. Rickard leaves a wife and two children, one a boy of ten and the other a baby.
