Webster County Roads Excellent

County Commissioner Johnson has just returned from an automobile trip which took him through fourteen counties, and during the trip he paid especial attention to roads, bridges and culverts. The counties visited were Gage, Jefferson, Webster, Nuckolls, Adams, Kearney, Phelps, Dawson, Buffalo, Hall, Hamilton, York and Seward and he declared without hesitation that the best roads found during the entire trip were in York county and the worst in Dawson county. Webster county has the best bridges and culverts and the commissioners of that county seem to have the matter of handling flood waters down to a more scientific point than those of any other county visited by Mr. Johnson. No bump or jar notifies the traveler in that county that he has struck a bridge or culvert, and experienced road builders assert that this is a thing which is extremely hard to obviate.

Commissioner Johnson stated that Buffalo county is a close second to York on the matter of good roads, and the contrast between it and Dawson, lying directly west, is nothing short of startling. A big sign board marks the entrance from Dawson to Buffalo, but this would not be needed to show that the two territories are under different government.

The commissioner, who has been studying road work assiduously ever since he assumed office, about four years ago, learned many new and advantageous things during this trip, and things that he will be able to turn them to good account. He found the people everywhere interested in the good roads movement.—Lincoln Evening News.
