
AMENDMENT NO. THREE. The following proposed amendment to the countilation of the State of Nebruska, as hereinafter set forth in full, is submitted to the electors of the State of Neural election to be voted upon at the general election to be held Tuesday. November 3rd, A. D. 1814.

sand (81,000,00) indiary per annum, and the Lieutenant Governor shall receive one and one-half the compensation of a semitar, and after the adoption of this constitution they shall not receive to their own use any fees costs, interests upon public moneys in their hands, or under their control, perquisites of office or other compensation, and all fees that may hereafter be payable by law for services performed by an officer provided for in this article of the constitution shall be paid in advance into the state treasury. There shall be no allowance for clerk hire in the offices of the Superintendent of Public Instruction and Attorney General.

Sec. 2. That at said election on the Tuesday succeeding the first Monday in November, 1814, on the ballot of each elector voting thereat, there shall be printed or written the words: "For proposed amendments to the constitution, fixing the term of office and salary for governor, and other executive officers," and "Against proposed amendments to the constitution, fixing the term of office and salary for governor, and other executive officers."
