PUBLIC EXPENSES GROWING

Modern Civilization Demands Government Action in Numerous Ways Unthought of by Pioneer.

In pioneer days the people asked and expected very little from government...

The husbandman was at once his own carpenter, blacksmith, shoemaker, butcher...

Each family then cared for its own lame, halt, deaf, blind, imbecile and insane...

Protest against the burden of taxation is as constant as the operation of gravitation...

Accordingly, in every political campaign one may confidently expect the "outs" to charge the "ins" with extravagance...

In our article last week we pointed out a large number of items included in the eight million dollars appropriated by the legislature of 1913...

Pioneer days in Nebraska differ materially from those of Ohio, Michigan, Indiana and Illinois. The railroads to a very great extent preceded the settlers here...

Governor Morehead has repeatedly pointed out that of every hundred dollars raised in Nebraska by taxation, state and local, \$65 of it is spent in the cause of education...

The complexity of civilized life has resulted in an increasing number of specialists. The pioneer farmer's occupation is gone...

Let us see what we are willing to dispense with: Shall we (can we?) disband the national guard and save the \$77,680 appropriated for the adjutant general's office?

Do we really need state supervision of insurance companies? If not, we can save \$24,080 each two years.

Shall we cut down expenses by abolishing the labor commissioner's office and its \$10,680 appropriations?

Can we get along without the game and fish commission and save \$44,780 each biennium?

Is it class legislation to pay \$3,500 a year for a state veterinarian, and \$15,000 a year for the office expenses of the live stock sanitary board...

Is it worth \$27,750 per biennium for a board of commissioners to supervise all the state charitable and penal institutions?

Are the people benefited \$37,400 a year by the state banking board?

Does the state board of irrigation earn its \$27,880 in two years of service?

Is it well to pay \$12,530 every two years for the services and expenses of the state prison board and board of charities and correction?
