The American Sunday School Union Growing

The American Sunday School Union has just closed another year of successful work in the planning and caring for community Sunday Schools in needy rural and mining communities.

This is the oldest Sunday School Missionary Society in the United States and employs more missionaries than any similar organization in the world.

Rev. Joseph Wells is superintendent for the western district, with headquarters at Des Moines. His report of results accomplished in the western district is as follows:

Sunday Schools started, 264; teachers appointed, 876; scholars enrolled, 7,837; brought into existing schools, 1,114; total gathered into schools, 9,849; schools visited and aided, 2,690; homes visited, 45,918; addresses and sermons delivered, 3,452; bibles and testaments distributed, 4,177; Christian literature circulated, \$3,499.86; preaching stations opened, 43; Young People's Societies organized, 26; hopeful conversions reported, 1,111; denominational churches developed, 13; home departments organized, 42. C. P. Turner of Hastings is the local missionary for this part of the state.

Confes Village Ordinance No. 24.

An ordinance providing for and making a tax levy upon all the non-taxable property in the Village of Cowles, Nebraska, both real and personal for all general and special purposes as per the regular annual valuation of the same for the fiscal year beginning the first Tuesday in May 1915.

Be it ordained by the Chairman and Board of Trustees of the Village of Cowles, Nebraska:

SECTION 1. That the following taxes be and that the same are hereby levied upon all the assessable property in the Village of Cowles, Nebr., both real and personal as per the assessed valuation of the same for the year 1915, to wit: for general revenue purposes, Five mills on the dollar.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication.
