In Full Swing**

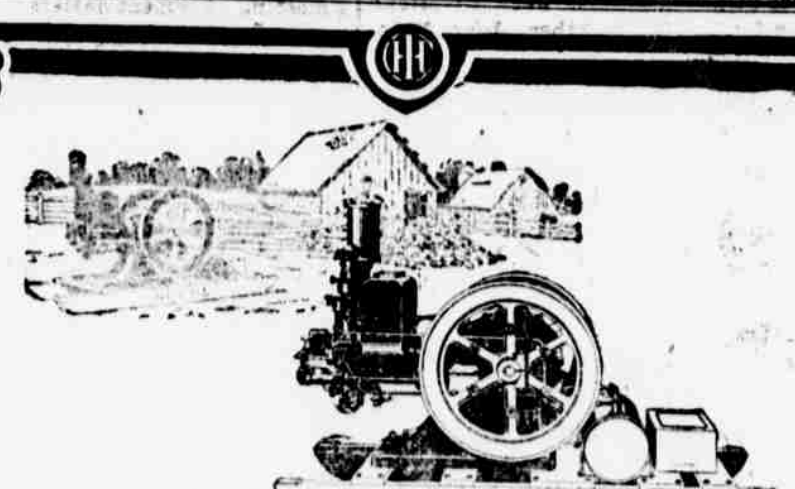
