118,123 Men Register

Figures received at the Governor's office on June 9 give the total registration in Nebraska as 118,123, of which number 110,466 are white and 1,457 colored. This leaves Nebraska nearly 11,000 short of the estimate of 129,000 eligible to military service.

Of the total number registering 63,774 whites and 822 colored citizens claimed exemption, while 46,022 whites and 635 colored men did not claim exemption.

The figures showed 5,044 aliens of countries at peace with our nation and 1,156 aliens of countries at war.

The Governor has heard from but one county where registrars will demand pay for their work and estimates that 95 per cent of registrars will offer their service to the government gratis.
