#### THE RED CLOUD HOME GUARDS BY-LAWS

1. NAME.—The name of this or-War fund ...... 1,222.74 ganization shall be the Red Cloud Home Guards.

2. OBJECT .- The object of this organization shall be to invoke the man power, to protect property, to inspire patriotism and encourage the spirit of home defense in time of war.

3. MEMBERSHIP .- (a) The mem-380.65 bers of the Red Cloud Home Guards shall be males of good character, residents of Red Cloud or vicinity of at least one year, citizens of the 520.00 such as provided by the naturaliz-100.00 ation laws, and able to read and write English. Provided; that the requirement of one year's residence in Red Cloud or vicinity shall only apply to persons who shall be received into this organization subsequent to the adoption of these by-laws.

(b) Any person eligible to mem- roll.
