## Illinois A. C. Star Splashes 100 in Fast Time

Swims Century Race in 53 Seconds Flat in 75-Foot Pool of Columbus University.

New York, March 31.—John Weissmuller of the Illinois athletic club, Chicago, established a new world's record of 53 seconds flat for the 100-yard indoor swimming event today. Weissmuller's feat was accomplished in the 75-foot pool of Columbus university under special athletic union sanction and timing.
