"I'll be good," I promised laughingly. "You'd better," she threatened. "Indeed, you really don't deserve to be told that because of that bit of my mind, please!"

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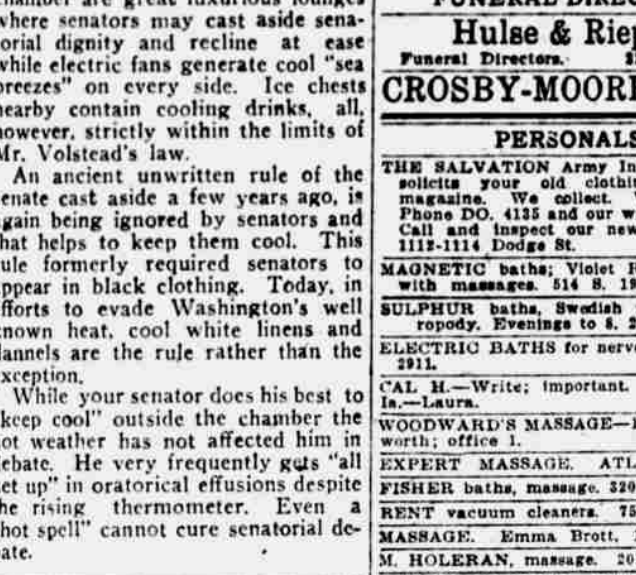

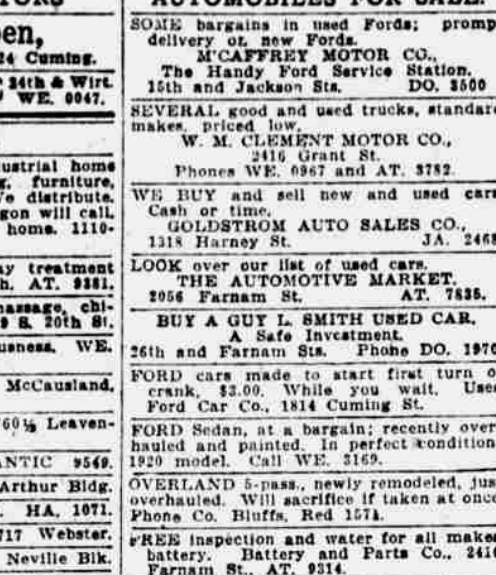
