So Says Omaha C. of C. Commissioner on Return From Trip to Pacific Coast.

J. David Larsen, commissioner of the Chamber of Commerce, returned yesterday from a two weeks' trip to the Pacific coast where, he declared, he found sentiment strongly crystallized in favor of the Union Pacific railroad taking over the Central Pacific.

Mr. Larsen has a copy of a resolution adopted by the Peninsula Association of Chambers of Commerce of California, stating that "The Union Pacific, if given control of the Central Pacific would guarantee compliance with the intent of the original act of congress of July 1, 1862, when the Omaha to San Francisco route was built."

The Southern Pacific got control of the Central Pacific many years after that, when the Union Pacific had serious financial difficulties.
