Lieutenants to Make Longest Army Flight. San Diego, Cal., July 22.—Lieutenants C. L. Weber and Virgil Hines of the army will leave Rockwell field here next week on one of the longest air mapping flights ever attempted by army aviators.

The flight will be made in accordance with plans of the air service to photograph thoroughly and map every air line in the United States.

The exact course of the fliers as announced is as follows: Rockwell field to San Francisco, San Francisco to Salt Lake, Salt Lake to Denver, Denver to Fort Hill, Okla.; Fort Hill to San Antonio, San Antonio to El Paso, El Paso to Nogales and thence back to San Diego.
