

# Buffaloes Solve Boehler's Offerings and Defeat League-Leading Oilers

**Omaha Gets to Tulsa Ace in Fourth Frame**

Tipple Hurls Steady Ball While Locals Win, 8 to 4—Griffin Crashes Homer in Second Frame.

INE Omaha Buffaloes had George Boehler, Western league hurling ace, and eight Tulsa Oilers an 8 to 4 defeat in the first game of the series here yesterday afternoon. That's saying quite a lot for the Buffaloes, considering the fact that the Oilers are hanging onto first place in the league race.

George hasn't been able to defeat the Buffaloes for quite a spell and yesterday's game was no exception. As in former games, the herd waited until the fourth inning to jump on Mr. Boehler. They hopped on George in the fourth for three runs and then picked him for a run in the fifth, sixth and two in the seventh.

Incidentally, the Buffaloes hurled a wrench into Boehler's winning machinery. George won 30 consecutive games until he bumped into the Buffaloes yesterday. Now he has to start all over again. Boehler can be satisfied even if the herd did beat him, for he holds the league record for straight wins.

**Tipple on Mound.**

Dan Tipple faced the Oilers and it was veteran against veteran. Daniel didn't mind the heat and twisted 'em over in dandy style, allowing the greasy Oilers five scattered hits and whipping something like five southerners. Some pitchers are troubled with the heat even in cold days, but yesterday Tipple tipped over the Oilers, Boehler and all, which is a pretty big feat.

Besides hurling good ball, Dan nabbed onto a couple of hits, one a fluke double out of three times at bat. Again, considering the hot weather, we'll say Tipple earned his day's pay, whatever it is. Boehler didn't do so good at the bat, Boehler clouted out a double out of four trips to the rubber. His double, however, scored the third Tulsa score, which bolted up in the seventh.

"Pug" Griffin, Buffalo out-fielder, carried away the hitting honors of the afternoon. Griffin took all the heart out of Boehler in the second inning when he slammed out a home run over the left field fence. In the fourth inning, "Pug" singled. The next time he came to bat, the Oilie hurler politely walked him. Griffin was at bat three times, made two hits and scored three times, a good day's work in any man's league.

**Errors of Omission.**

Several errors of omission on the part of the Oilers in the fourth, fifth and sixth didn't help Boehler any. In the fourth, Omaha scored three runs on a double, single, double and another single. In the fifth, Tipple got his fluke double, was boosted to third on an infield out and scored on a sacrifice fly. Dan's run put the game on ice, but no one knew it at the time.

A base on balls, sacrifice hit and a double counted another Buffalo in the sixth, while Tipple's single and "Whiz" Gislason's home run over the right field fence scored the final two Omaha runs.

Tulsa took the end in the second inning when two singles, sacrifice and Croby's double cleaned the bags. The Buffaloes forged ahead in the fourth never to be headed. However, one Oilie greased the pants in the seventh on two bases on balls and Stuart's double. Apperson's errors out in the left garden helped Tulsa score another in the eighth. A sacrifice scored the Oilers' final score in this inning.
