The newly formed organization of shopmen now employed on the Union Pacific will only serve to strengthen the old unions, now on strike, on that line, officers of the Union Pacific Federation of Shopmen No. 105 asserted this morning.

Such an organization can be nothing more than a company union, or an adaptation of the so-called "American plan," said H. H. Furse, president of the system federation.

The meeting was held in the company headquarters, and was opened by a company man. The public will not be fooled by claims made for such an organization. The officers probably were selected by the company. They will be unpaid representatives, hence they must work in the shops to make a living.
