Golf Facts

Q Is there a restriction as to the distance a player has to walk back to the hole after the ball has been lifted from casual water in the fairway?

A Yes, the rule provides that the ball be dropped within two club-lengths of the margin as near as possible to where the ball lay in the casual water.

Q What is the penalty if any, in the common case, when a player is getting out of a bunker and his ball is in the hole when he reaches the hole?

A The player loses the hole in match play and two strokes in medal play.

Q In a match play, if the player who has the honor on the next hole, drops his first ball out of bounds, can he wait until his opponent plays before he plays his second ball?

A Yes, the rule provides that play begins by each player taking a ball from the teeing ground.

Q It is necessary to play a second ball from the tee, but has the right to have his opponent take his turn at playing?

Q When a player has lifted a ball and the ball is in the hole, is he required to drop it again?

A The player is not required to drop it again. There is no penalty.
