Omaha Grain

Omaha, Sept. 20.
 Liverpool wheat cables were strong and higher this morning, being favorably influenced by the more unsatisfactory news from Turkey and this strength was reflected in a higher range of prices in our markets, corn and oats being especially strong. Export business was very slow, in some instances bids from the other side were higher than yesterday, but still below a workable basis. There was also very little domestic demand, but receipts were not burdensome and the main influence in price making was the situation at Constantinople.

Total receipts at Omaha were 147 cars, consisting of 104 cars wheat, 28 cars of corn, 12 cars of oats and 3 cars of rye and barley, and compared with a total run of 150 cars last year. Total shipments were 109 cars, against 177 cars a year ago.

There was a good demand for cash wheat in the Omaha market and the offerings were cleaned up at prices ranging from 1c to 2c higher, generally 2c up. Corn was in active demand, total receipts being 109 cars. Oats sold 1/4c to 1c up. Rye was 1c higher and barley 1c to 2c up.

Chicago Grain

 Chicago, Sept. 20.—Grain markets were extremely sensitive to reports regarding political developments in Europe.

The fear that there might be a clash between the British and Turkish forces to the general buying, with an increase in the general trade, wheat advanced to within a fraction of the outside figure on Monday's bulge. Corn and oats sold at a new high on the present uptrend.

Best prices of the day were made toward the last, with wheat gaining 2 7/8c on wheat, 1 1/4c to 1 3/4c on corn, 1 1/8c to 1 1/4c on oats and 1 1/4c to 1 1/2c on rye.

The advance in wheat prices was persistent. At no time was there any material pressure. Commission houses traded broadly. Each cable telling of fresh developments abroad was followed by renewed buying. That carried prices higher than here before during the day. Many of the local traders took the bull side.

Domestic wheat connections were persistent buyers.

Wheat Leads Advance.
 Wheat was inclined to drag for a brief period early but later led the advance, closing at 1 1/4c to 1 1/2c. Kansas City September gained to 1 1/4c. The market was very active, although demand was quiet, although accompanied with a relatively firmer, compared with future contracts.

Corn and oats showed independent strength. Corn advanced 1/4c to 1 1/4c. There was more than a fractional reaction to a report that the Chicago market appeared to have been taken off the market on the recent decline.

Wheat was reported as good buyers of December corn early. There were inquiries for large quantities of wheat which could not be filled on account of the tight market. The market for December sold at the best figures since late in July. Cash premiums were firmer.

 New York, Sept. 20.—Probably the judgment of the markets regarding the Turkish complication was best expressed by the recovery in foreign exchange rates and by the rise of 1 to 2 points in French government bonds in the Paris bourse and of a point in the French 7-1/2 per cent in New York. Sterling at today's highest sold above any rate quoted in the past 10 days and 2 5/8 cents above the low rate of last week, while franc advances nearly back to last week's highest figures.
