

Attacks on Code Lose Force as Tax Explained

Governor Finds Taxpayers Eager Listeners to Benefits Accruing From Present Law.

Lincoln, Sept. 21. (Special.)—Governor McKelvie finds that the people are eager to get information about the code departments of the state government and what they are handling. He is of the opinion that the code will be so well understood in a short time that opponents will not attract much attention.

"When the people come to understand just two things about the code," the governor said, "it will cease to be of political interest. The first is that the activities carried on under the code were performed before the code bill passed or were created by separate acts of the state legislature. The second is that the code department collects in revenue a quarter of a million of dollars annually in excess of their operation."

Governor McKelvie indicated that C. W. Bryan had struck the popular chord relative to the inspectors under the code. He pointed out that this was because the people do not realize that state inspectors were employed before the code bill became a law. He considered them more vigilant now. Inspectors were political jobs before the day of the code. He indicated that he was preparing a statement for the purpose of showing the number of inspectors employed and what work they performed before and after the code bill functioned.

Further Inflation

"When time came for the floating of the Victory loan, it was generally believed that the peak of inflation had been reached. Becoming fearful of the successful floating of the Victory loan, the democratic administration opened up the throttle and encouraged further inflation. Instead of relying on the loyalty and patriotism of the people, they resorted to further inflation. People were encouraged to create indebtedness on the basis of a 50-cent dollar, and investments were so made. Taking cognizance of the fact that the government should not indulge further in the unwise practice of undue inflation, within six months after the Victory loan episode a policy of drastic deflation was adopted, and bankers were privately told that if they so much as loaned farmers a sufficient amount of money to properly market their crops the support of the
