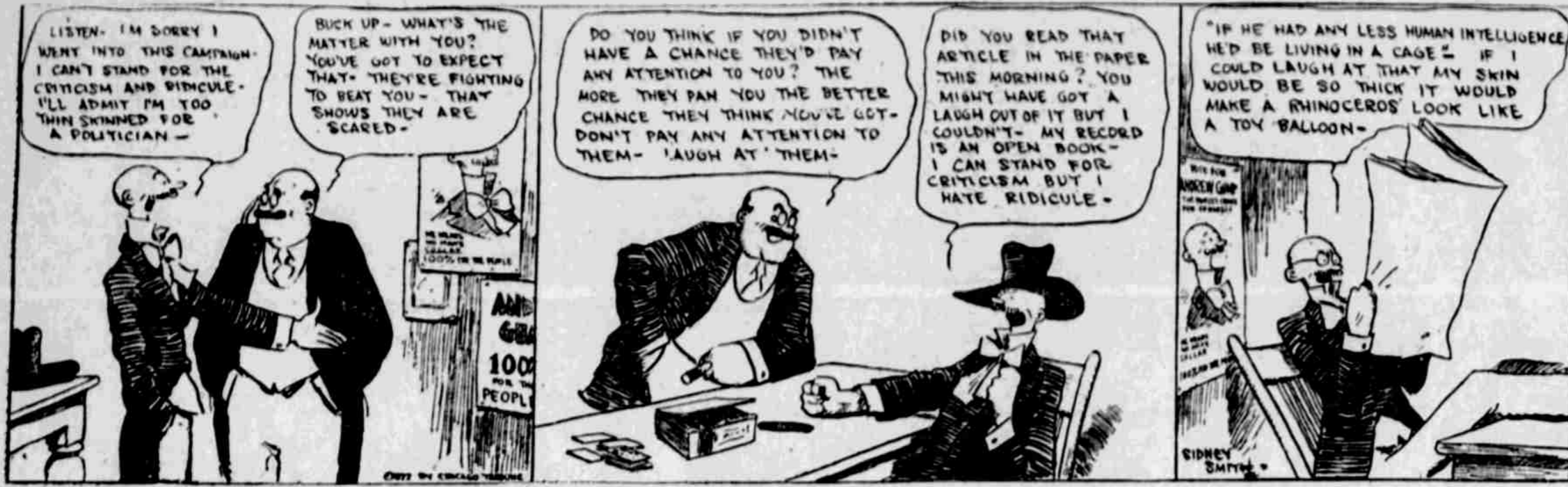

Figures Dispute Bryan's Report on Farm Taxes

Democratic Nominee Claims His Taxes Increased Almost \$300—Statement Shows Only \$221.

Lincoln, Sept. 29.—(Special)—Positive and specific contradiction of tax figures cited by C. W. Bryan, democratic candidate for governor, covering his own farm in Lancaster county, was forthcoming today in a statement issued by Governor McKelvie's office.

Further, it is shown that only 15 per cent of his 1922 charitable and state government, whereas in 1917 the state received 32 per cent.

In 1917 the school tax represented only 25 per cent of the Bryan tax; in 1922 it was 69 per cent. His state tax is \$17.45 less than in 1921 and his school tax is \$21.15 more.

Summed up, the Bryan state tax advanced only from \$19.97 to \$40.13 in the last five years, while the county tax advanced from \$25.67 to \$28.82 and the school tax from \$15.31 to \$15.52.

Of the \$20.14 increase in Mr. Bryan's tax in five years, \$4.01 went for the relief of ex-soldiers; \$5.23 for the new state capital; \$3.84 for roads and bridges; \$2.17 for the state university; 56 cents for the normal schools; \$1.92 for the state charitable and penal institutions; 54 cents for aiding weak school districts; 39 cents for eradication of animal diseases, leaving an increase of only \$2.19 for the general state government.

Pilots to Attempt Nonstop Flight

Aviators Expect to Hop Off on Transcontinental Trip October 5.

Washington, Sept. 29.—Plans for the nonstop flight from San Diego, Cal., to New York, to be attempted by Lieuts. Oakley G. Kelly of Grove City, Pa., and John A. MacReady of Los Angeles, as announced by the air service, indicate that the start will probably be made October 5.

Air service engineers have about completed the remodeling of the monoplane T-2, in which the transcontinental trip is to be attempted. The two pilots will be sent so that they can plot and eight passengers and to have a normal gasoline capacity of 130 gallons with a flight endurance of about six hours.

As remodeled, the T-2 will carry 725 gallons of gasoline distributed in three tanks, together with reserve water and lubricating oil tanks.
