

Figures Dispute Bryan's Report on Farm Taxes

Democratic Nominee Claims His Taxes Increased Almost \$300-Statement Shows Only \$221.

Ancoln, Sept. 29.—(Special.)—Post tive and specific contradiction of tax figures cited by C. W. Bryan, democraic candidate for governor, covering his own farm in Lancaster county, was forthcoming today in a statement issued by Governor McKelvie's office. Bryan, in speeches, has claimed that his taxes on 160 acres had increased from almost nothing to \$300. The figures show that the 1922 Bryan tax was only \$221.31, a reduction of

\$5.42 from that of 1921 and \$43.26 from 1920. Further, it is shown that only 18 per cent of his 1922 tax went to the state government, whereas in 1917

the state received 32 per cent. In 1917 the school tax represented only 25 per cent of the Bryan tax; in they learned during the last term. 1922 it was 69 per cent. His state tax is \$17.46 less than in 1921 and his and county tax combined.
